f. If you have applied for a Part-Time Ph.D. program, you must provide proof of experience gained after completion of qualifying degree of at least 1 year (as on 28 Dec. 2018) and bring a No-Objection Certificate from your current employer. If you have applied for a Full Time Sponsored Ph.D. program, you must provide proof of experience gained as per minimum Institute criteria after completion of qualifying degree (as on 28 Dec. 2018) and bring sponsorship certificate from your current employer. The formats of these certificates are described in the information brochure (available at institute website). The Part-Time and Full-Time (Sponsored) candidates are required to bring NOC as per the format of the Institute. If the NOC format is different from the institute-suggested format, the candidate may be allowed appear for interview. However, the selection of candidate will be provisional, subject to approval of NOC by Dean (Academics). Without NOC, no candidates will be interviewed.

**Preparation:** Please come prepared for a personal interview. Revise your fundamentals in the courses that you have taken which are most relevant to the research area provided by you in your application.

**Accommodation:** Hostel accommodation for male students, coming for interviews, is available in **Kumaon**. For female candidates hostel accommodation is available in **Kailash** Hostel. If you wish to avail this facility, please contact the caretaker at reception of the appropriate hostel upon arrival. The telephone numbers of the hostels are: Kumaon: 011 2659-6992 and Kailash: 011 2659-6839. You may stay as a guest in these hostels at a nominal charge of Rs.400/- per day, which includes boarding

and lodging (you need to bring your own bedding lock). The Caretaker of concerned hostel will help to arrange bedding @ Rs. 50/- (Per set) Per day. The payment shall be made by way of Demand Draft drawn in favor of “Deans Discretionary Fund ..... (Hostel name) Hostel”. You will have to give the undertaking at the time of hostel allotment that you will not use any motor driven vehicle in the campus.
