Requirement of qualification in GATE / National Exam is waived for the following categories of applicants:

- I. Currently registered students in Centrally Funded Technical Institutes (CFTIs) having CGPA of 8.00 or above (on a 10 point scale) at the end of 6th semester or later, in B. Tech./B.E./ Integrated M. Tech./ Integrated M. Sc. Programmes (or any other programme of minimum four year duration, admission to which is on the basis of JEE), the requirement of GATE / National Exam is waived for consideration of admission to the M.S. (R) programme in IIT Delhi. Moreover, such students must have obtained a CGPA of 8.00 or above at the time of graduation (and before they formally register for the M.S.(R) programme).
- II. Graduates of CFTIs (in the programmes marked under (i)) with a final graduation CGPA of more than 8.000 (80% aggregate marks, if marks is the primary mode of evaluation);
- III. M.A or M.Sc. graduates from IITs with CGPA 8.000 or above.

The center research committee (CRC) meeting was held on 10-05-2022 at 10.50 A.M. through M.S. Team video conferencing call. The following members were present.


