a) Requirement of qualification in GATE/National Exam is waived for the following categories of applicants:

- i) Currently registered students in Centrally Funded Technical Institutes (CFTIs) pursuing B.Tech/B.E./Integrated M.Tech/Integrated M.Sc. programmes, who have completed 6 semesters or more and have CGPA of 8.0 or above (on a 10 point scale). Such students must obtain a CGPA of 8.0 or above at the time of graduation, and before they formally register for the Ph.D. programme (80% aggregate marks, if marks is the primary mode of evaluation);
- ii) Graduates of CFTIs (in the programmes marked under (i)) with a final graduation CGPA of more than 8.0 (80% aggregate marks, if marks is the primary mode of evaluation);
- iii) M.A. or M.Sc. graduates from IITs with CGPA 8.0 or above..
